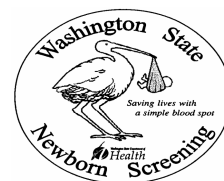

Driving directions from Interstate-5 Northbound

The laboratory is approximately 3 miles north of the Northgate shopping center.

- ?? Exit I-5 at N.E. 145th street (Exit #175), and get into the far RIGHT LANE.
- ?? Turn RIGHT (Eastbound) on N.E. 145th Street at the traffic light.
- ?? Drive in the left lane, past the golf course, to the first traffic light, at 15th Avenue N.E.
- ?? Turn LEFT on 15th Avenue. N.E. (Starbucks is to the right, a QFC is across the street).
- ?? Drive 4 blocks on 15th to N.E. 150th Street.
- ?? Turn RIGHT onto N.E. 150th Street.
- ?? Turn left into W.R. Giedt Public Health Laboratories, which is the second **open** driveway on the left.

Driving directions from Interstate-5 Southbound

- ?? Exit I-5 at N.E. 145th street (Exit #175).
- ?? Turn LEFT (Eastbound) on N.E. 145th Street at the traffic light.
- ?? Cross the overpass and drive past the golf course, to the second traffic light, at 15th Avenue N.E.
